Neighbors and Patrons,

This year's pandemic has certainly created a challenging year for Mountain Deli, and restaurants around the world. We've had to become flexible and open to the many rules, regulations, best practices and changes necessary and required to maintain a safe restaurant environment and business. Our first priority at the Deli is and always has been to provide a safe and secure establishment for our staff to work in and our patrons to enjoy.

For the safety of yourself and the staff, the Deli will be following guidelines as issued by the CDC, the National and State Restaurant Associations and our local Health Department. We may also choose to implement our own policies as we feel necessary to ensure safe service.

Although we recognize that you, as U.S. citizens have "rights and liberties", keep in mind that we also have "rights and liberties" as a private restaurant; including the right to refuse service to anyone who is not willing to follow our requirements for service.

Requirements for Service

- 1. If you or someone in your family is sick, coughing or showing viral symptoms please do not enter the Deli.
- 2. You must wear a mask or some kind of facial covering while inside the building...ordering, paying or moving about. Masks may be removed when you are seated and eating.
- 3. Use the hand sanitizer at the station near the door when you enter. Use the bathroom sinks to wash your hands.
- 4. Maintain 6' of distance between yourself and others.
- 5. Only occupy the booths that are not blocked off.
- 6. No parties larger than four persons will be permitted at any one table inside the Deli.
- 7. You must wait outside the door to be called in by the staff before you may enter. One party at a time.
- 8. Follow all directions of staff as given.

Note: The staff is temperature monitored & health checked every day before their shift. They are extremely concerned about their personal safety and appreciate safe patrons.
